A four man dance. Music Not For Joe, A B, Single stepped.

## Chorus,

General rule middles back out - left, ends go in (face out) - right, this continues round in a clockwise direction. Partners keep together.

## Second figure

Arm swing grab right elbows (stick swaps to the left shoulder), halfway through the music change direction (stick swaps to the right shoulder) and back to place.

Third figure,

Sheep pens, middles back out for two ends adjust in to form a four 1

Arms reach in and grab the wrist of the preceding person to form a sheep pen dance round to position (break early!).

Fourth figure

Back to Back

With partner forward two, side for two, back four - all the time looking for lines with partners. Then

Forward two, side two, and four back to position.

Fifth figure

Go right.

Go out four steps fast and furious, turn tight right and pause back in to clash, across the set for a further three and tight turn - return to place.

End figure, as for figure one but dance a reel and a half and then circle the musicians sticks held pointing in and over the heads of the musicians. When the music restarts turn clockwise and out.
